

CHESTER SHORES EAST AND WEST BEACH RULES☒

- 1.** The beach is for the use of members and guests. **There is a 15 person limit per household on the beach at any one time. For parties larger than 15 people approval by the board of directors is required. Failure to meet this rule is subject to fines and loss of privileges.**
2. There is no lifeguard on duty. **One adults must be present when swim area in use. Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult.** Swim at your own risk.
3. Swimming alone is not permitted.
4. Swimming after dark is not permitted.
- 5.** Diggers are required to level the sand after play. **(A \$25.00 fine will be imposed on the household who fails to meet this requirement.)***
6. Animals are not permitted on the beach areas.
- 7.** Glassware, trash and cigarette butts are not permitted in the beach area
- 8.** Fires are not permitted outside the fireplace area and must be extinguished. **It is required that the fireplace and fire pit area be cleaned and free of debris other than extinguished fire wood after each use.(A \$25.00 fine will be imposed on violators.)***
9. Boats and skiers are not permitted in the swimming area. Canoes, **kayaks**, and sailboats can be launched from designated area.
10. Fishing from the swimming dock is not permitted.
- 11. Parking is allowed in the designated area at the beach. Cars must display their permit when parked at these areas. Cars parked illegally will be towed at the owners' expense.**
- 12. No Swimming off boat docks**
